To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is in regard to your recent inquiry for a Safety Data Sheet (SDS) for one or more of our SARANEX[®] film products.

All SARANEX[®] 520, 540 and 560 Vapor Retarder films and tapes are considered “articles” as defined by 29 CFR 1910-1200, and as such are not classified as hazardous materials. An article is a manufactured item which:

1. is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture;
2. which has end use function(s) dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during end use; and
3. which does not release a hazardous chemical under normal conditions of use.

Normal conditions of use for SARANEX[®] products do not require the material to be handled, cut, or burned in any manner that could result in potential exposure to hazardous chemicals. As a result, we do not produce or supply MSDS or SDS sheets for SARANEX[®] products. However, if you have a specific concern, we will do our best to provide the needed information.
